
Figure 1: Maternal mortality per 100,000 live births by stillbirth+neonatal mortality per 1,000 births, based on UN mortality estimates for 151 countries, 2000 (upper panel) and 2020 (lower panel)






Figure 2: Selected characteristics by mortality transition phase, 149 countries, 2000 and 2020




Figure 3 Health financing and health workforce indicators by transition phase, 138 countries, 2017




Figure 4: Coverage of antenatal and delivery care, by transition phase, national surveys, 2000-2020




Figure 5: Inequalities in institutional births and C-sections, by wealth quintiles, by mortality transition stage, national surveys during 2000-2020
