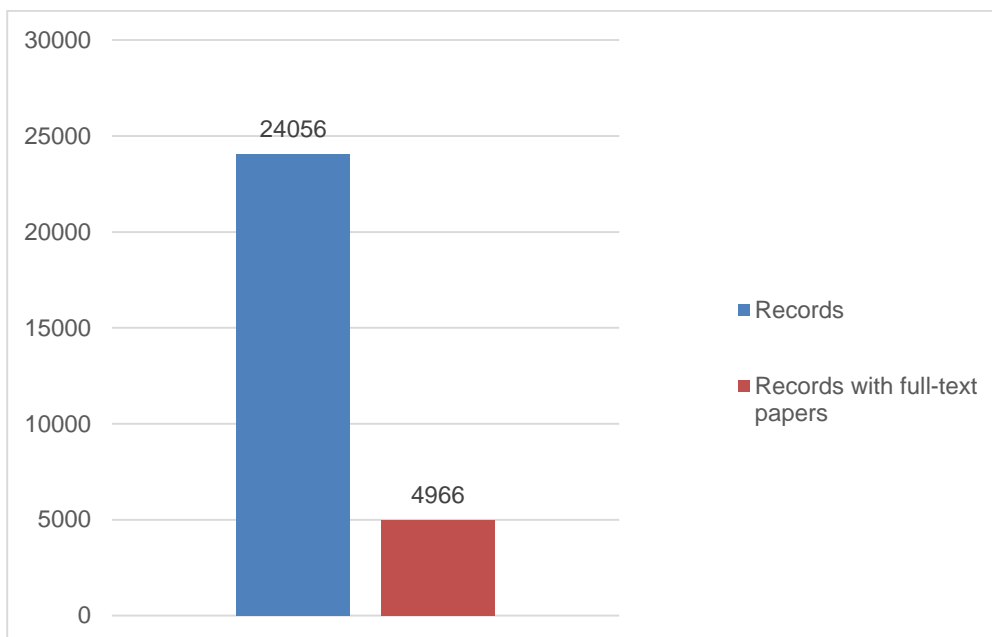

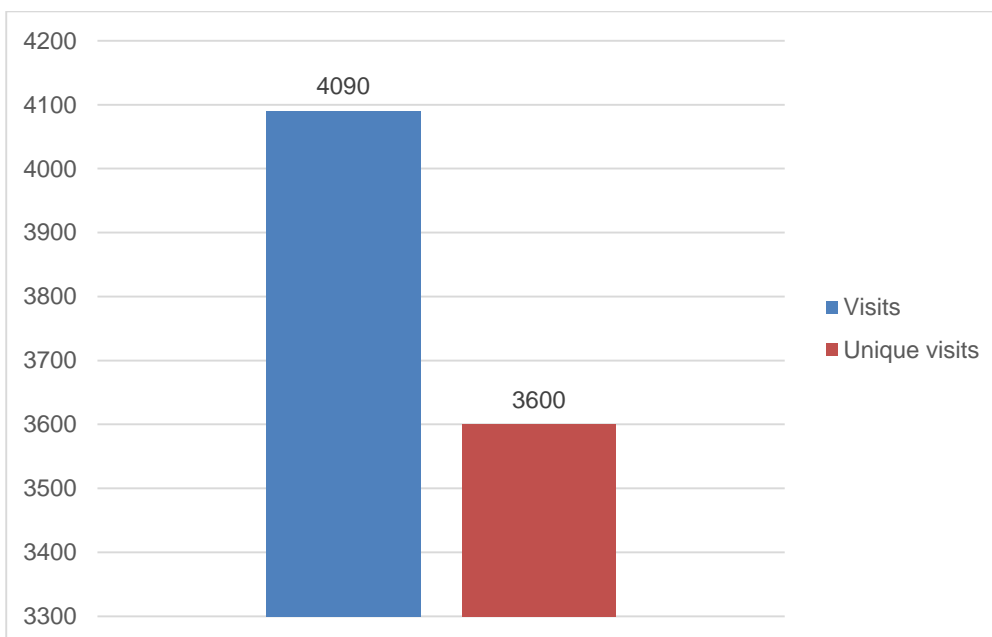

Total number of records in LSHTM Research Online at 31st December 2013

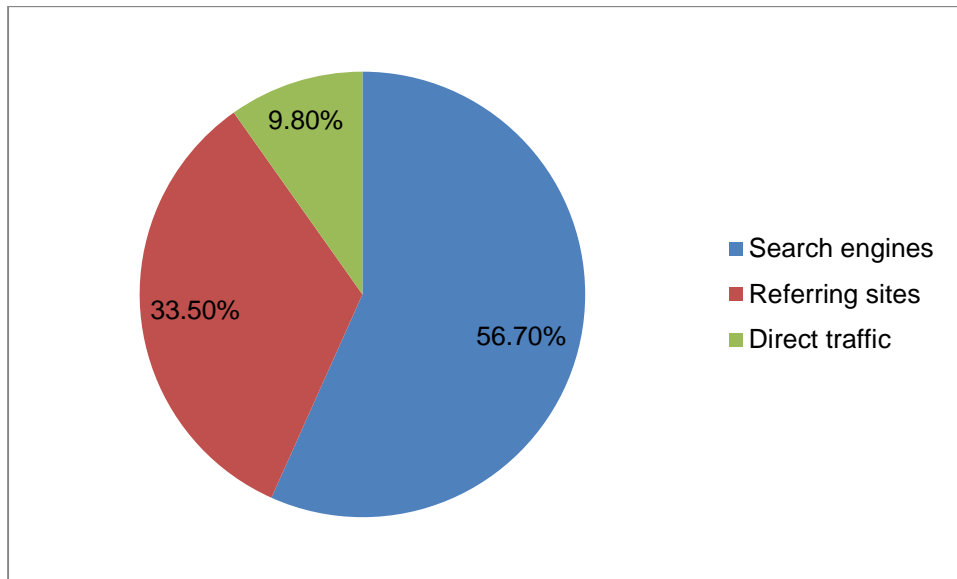


Visits to LSHTM Research Online during December 2013

December 2013



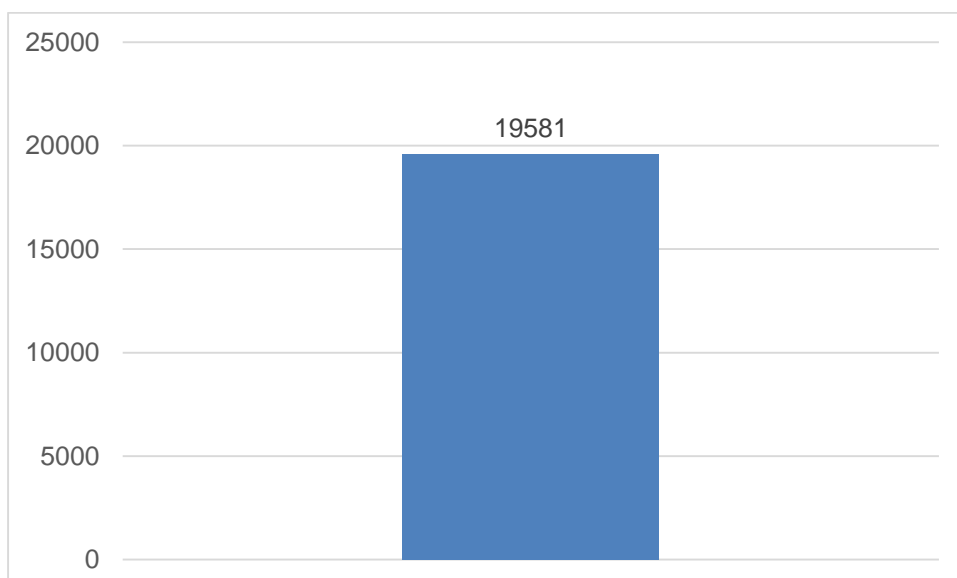
Traffic source definitions

Search engines: visitors coming via a search engine

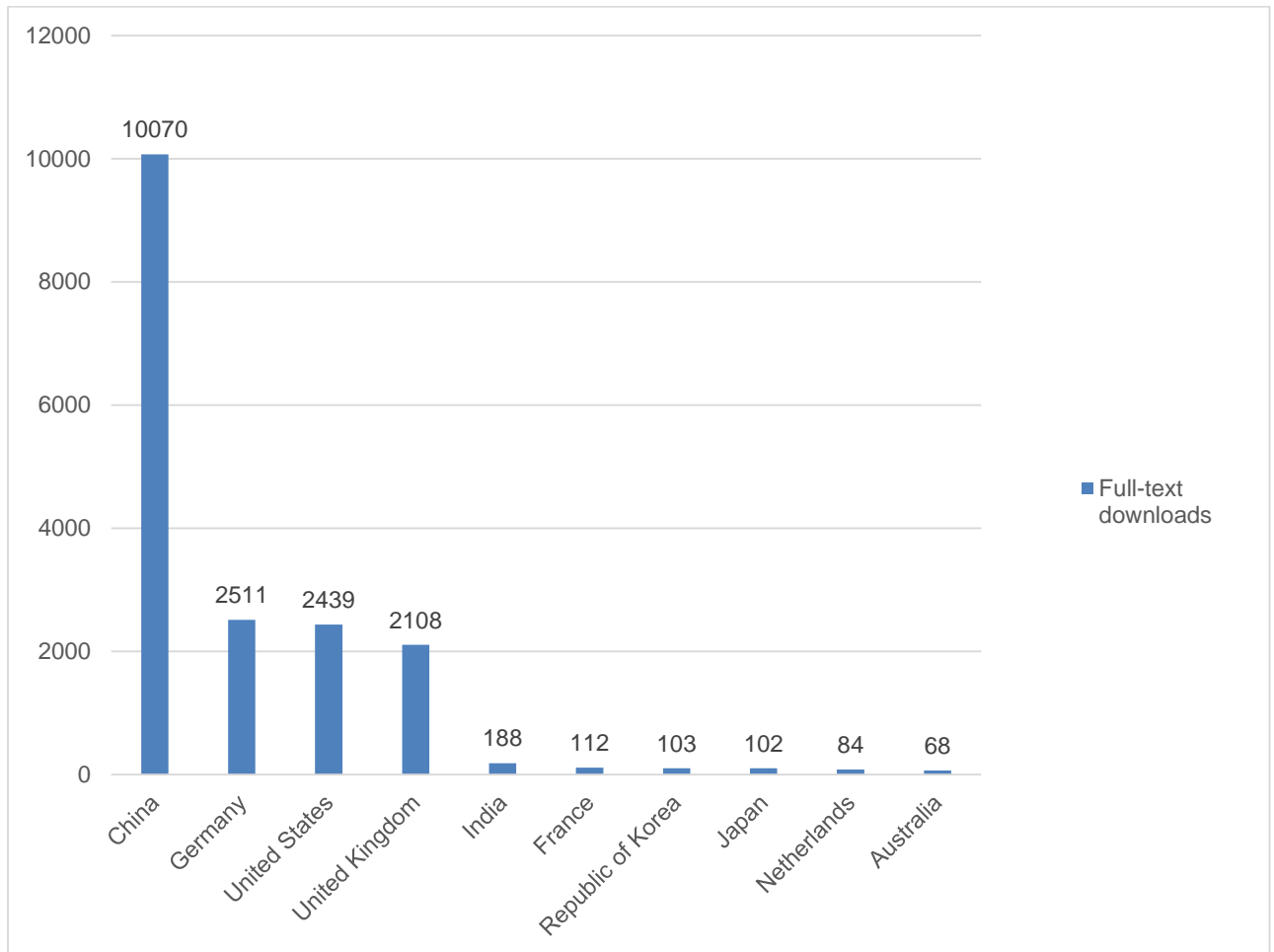
Referring sites: visitors referred by links on other websites
